\*\$500 Medical Emergency fund\* - to be brought by team leader for emergencies. A team leader should have this cash on hand or in a credit card for any injury emergency to pay at the hospital.

We encourage our teams to get involved in ministry and relationship building. Team members should think of the talents and gifts God has given them to use them in a class setting where we can invite students and the community. Team members should come up with and prepare seminars or workshops to be taught during their stay and/or to get involved with MLV classes.

Past seminars have been: Baking pies, Internet and how it works, Basic electric switch installation, Cake decorating, Christmas ornament craft, Hand-made announcement cards, Sewing classes, Basic guitar, Crochet 101, English 1, Conversation, Personality types, Dispensation of the church, Spiritual gifting, etc. We look forward to what you can teach us! We ask that all team members who are Christians be prepared to give a devotional or testimony.

Additionally, teams can prepare a children's program, visit the sick in the community or in the hospital, do street ministry and give care packs. We also welcome teams with a medical emphasis, art emphasis, or music emphasis.



With these exciting opportunities, we hope our teams will collaborate with us on certain projects that could not otherwise be completed without their help. This year we have several projects that we would like to see realized. Teams should pick one or several of the projects to fund and/or help work on during their trip.

**Team Projects and costs:**

**\$16,000** - Build a house for a needy family. This is something Cocal Gracias has been able to do every other year. It is a tangible and amazing way to change the lives of a needy family and to partner with God in a blessing.

**\$10,000 -\$15,000** Continue the construction of Timothy Center, our youth center in Agua Caliente. This is an exciting new center that Cocal Gracias is starting in partnership with the Nazarene church in Agua Caliente, to create a safe, productive, God-inspiring place for children in the mountains.

**\$4,500** – Patio Roof at MLV- Our patio receives extreme heat in the summer and extreme rain in the winter. We would like to build a roof over it to help protect the students and give us a large multi-functional area to serve many needs. This project will also provide our welding students with practice.

**\$4,500** Raise a house in the community that is susceptible to flooding. This involves raising the walls, pouring a new floor, electrical, and roofing.

**\$3,000** – End-of-Semester party donation to help with the costs. (We have two parties each year. We invite the student body, family and friends out to a park.)

\*Funds may be given toward a specific project, or given in general to help with several most pertinent projects.\*
